What you will see is firsthand testimony by the eyewitness #1.

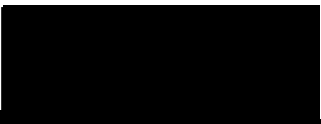
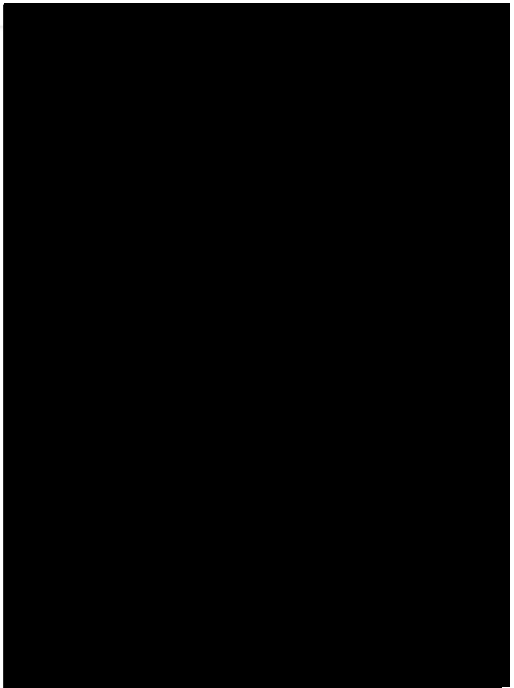

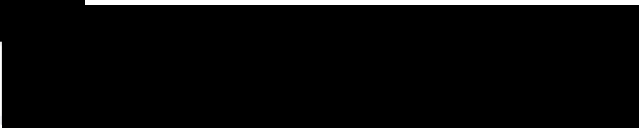
